1. SENDING IT THROUGH THE MAIL (USPS) to Mt. Zion Baptist Church, 33 Oak Street, Springfield, MA 01109. [Only checks or money orders should be sent via the United States Postal Service.]

**2. DROPPING IT OFF IN PERSON** in the brown mailbox labeled "Mt. Zion Only," which is to the right of the Orleans Street entrance.

**3. GIVING IT ON-LINE THROUGH GIVELIFY:** Download and use the free app, 'Givelify.' A picture of the outside of the Church should assure you that you have the correct organization.

4. GIVING IT THROUGH CASH APP: Download and use the free app, "Cash App." When you give a donation/ offering through Cash App, it is <u>extremely im-</u> <u>portant</u> that you use the correct Cash App Tag. Our Cash Tag is...

# LET'S ELIMINATE OUR DEBT: PROJECT IMPACT PHASE III

As was announced at our Anniversary celebration in September, one of our goals for the next two years will be to eliminate our mortgage debt. We're calling the plan, "Project Impact Phase III."

Through faith and the help and support of all members, we can pay off our mortgage early. Here's how...

Between January 1, 2024, and December 31, 2025 (the next 2 years), individuals or teams are asked to commit to giving \$3,500.00 over and beyond your normal tithes and offering.

Monies can be donated in your name, your Team's name, or in memory of a loved one.

Teams can be comprised of members of your household, your family and friends, or other Mt. Zion members. Each Team determines how much each of its team members needs to contribute to reach the \$3500.00 goal. [Note: If you want to be on a Team, but do not know any Team to join, we can help you with that.]

#### An 'official' kick-off for Project Impact Phase III is planned for next month.
